FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS ABOUT THE VOTING PROCESS

- 1. What are we deciding?
 - We are deciding whether the neighborhood name "Mosby Woods" should **CHANGE** or **REMAIN.**
- 2. What happens after the vote?
 - If the vote is REMAIN, nothing further will be considered. If the vote is CHANGE, a process to determine a new name will begin.
- 3. Who is administering the process?

 The MWCA (Mosby Woods Community Association).
- 4. Who is eligible to participate?

 All individual residents of the Mosby Woods

 peighborhood who are 18 years of age or older
 - neighborhood who are 18 years of age or older, as well as non-resident neighborhood homeowners.
- 5. How do I cast my ballot?
 - Go to https://tinyurl.com/36pdff74 or scan the QR code on the front with your smartphone camera app; both will take you to a Google Form, which is your ballot. Fill in your choice and the required eligibility information, then click on the blue SUBMIT button.

- 6. What eligibility information is required?Your name, address, and year (not date) of birth the year of birth question is to verify the age requirement is met.
- 7. When does the polling period begin and end?

 The polling period is open now. It ends at midnight on Friday, March 31, 2023. Since the process is online, the results will be announced shortly thereafter and available on www.mosbywoods.org.
- 8. What if I can't vote online?
